

Said Greenville District. Know all men by these presents that I William Pollard Senior of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John Ashmore Sr of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and release and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Ashmore a part of a tract of land originally granted to John Pyle Sen by his excellency Wm Moultrie on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785. the land to be conveyed beginning on a post Oak by the side of the Mill Road Et. Pollard's Corner thence running S 64<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> East 27 ch to a pine formerly a Black Jack thence running South West 35 chs 50 links to a pine corner thence westwardly along George Craft's line to a Stone corner near his fence thence North West on Craft's line to a Red Oak thence South West on Craft's line to a Red Oak thence West on Craft's line to a Maple joining John S. Mayfield on the branch thence up the branch on Mayfield's line to the road to a Rock on the fork Shoal Road thence running North Eastwardly to a large Spanish Oak on Meeting House Road thence running Eastwardly down to the beginning corner also it being a part of a tract of land granted to Robert Cilliland including One hundred acres of land more or less appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Ashmore Sr his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same In Witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this the twenty ninth day of September 1841
