Now given granted, bargained and sold and by these presents Do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward Gantt his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on the waters of Saluda River, being the tract of land formerly owned by John Gordon, and containing Five Hundred acres be the same more or less, being part of a tract of land granted to Harris Muller but surveyed for John Ruge and conveyed to the said John Gordon (since deceased) by Waddy Thompson, Putting and bounding as follows "to wit" Beginning on a Red Oak 3x and running thence N^o 80^o to a P. Oak 3x thence E about 35^o or 40^o to the Road, thence along Craufords line (now of Richard Gantt) to the old original line, thence along the original line to the beginning which said tract of land was conveyed to the said Thomas John Gantt by J. H. Rosemond, by deeds bearing date the 18th day of December 1833. Together with all and singular the Rights Members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

I Have and Do Hold all and singular the premises unto the said Edward Gantt his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Thomas John Gantt for myself my heirs Executors and administrators do hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edward Gantt his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and administrators and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, by, through or under me.
