John Dill Deed for 375 acres of land

To
Thomas Mitchell of South Carolina & Greenville District presents that I John Dill
of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of Five Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by
Thomas Mitchell of said State and District. I have granted
bargained sold and released unto the said Thomas Mitchell
Three Tracts of land containing three hundred and seventy
five acres. be the same more or less. Originally granted
to Daniel Dutton. Amrose Dill and others Deed granted 5th of
January 1789 and the 5 January 1801. and conveyed to Joseph Evans
by Theron Earle, John Montgomery, and John Miller by deeds dated
27 May 1815. Beginning at a Red Oak running South west to a
chestnut a conditional corner made by Joseph Evans Solomon
Dill. Thence North West a conditional line to a chestnut a
corner of said tract of land, thence N 20 E. to the branch thence
down said branch to the fork of Wild Cat creek thence up
the South fork of said creek to an Ash on the south side, thence
North West to a poplar station thence to a stake corner thence
a straight line to a stake in T. Moseley's corner thence with
Moseley's line to a post Oak, thence east the original line to
a Post Oak. ~~thence~~ and chestnut on the side of Pack Mountain
the original corner thence to a post Oak on land granted
to Amrose Dill. thence to a pine corner thence to a Post
Oak corner. thence to a chestnut corner. thence to a chestnut
station. thence to a Red Oak on the original Duttons line
thence to a chestnut joining on that line, thence S 65 West
to a Black Jack. thence N 40 W. to a pine corner thence to the
