Two Hundred & seventy Dollars and twenty five cents. to me paid
by Joseph M. Cullough of the same place, have granted bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Joseph M. Cullough a small
plantation or tract of land wherein Minor Nejon now lives
containing fifty four and a fourth acres (more or less) situate
in the State and District aforesaid lying on Mountain Creek
waters of Saluda River. Beginning on a White Oak 34 on Mountain
Creek running thence N 88 E. 13.75 to a Stake 34 bounded by J. Fur-
ch's land thence North 31.86 to a Stone 34 thence N 80 W. 5.14 to a
Red Oak 34 thence S 54 W. 1.00 to Red Oak 34 thence N 51 W. 50 to a Stake
34 thence S 16 W. 5.51 to a Stake 34 thence S 78 E. 9.50 to a Stake 34
thence N 82 W. 5.50 to a poplar 34 thence S 5 W. 4. to a Stake where
hickory 34 was thence N 83 W. 13.50 to a Stake 34 on the said creek
thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning
corner. Together with all and singular the rights members her-
-ditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
