 or persons whomsoever, renounce release and forever relinquish
 unto the said William Grisham his heirs and assigns
 forever all her right title interest and estate and also
 all her right and claims of Dower of in or to all and
 singular the premises within mentioned and released
 Given under my hand & seal this 25 Decr 1838.

 that tract or plantations of lands situated lying and being
 in Greenville District and State aforesaid on the waters
 of South Tyger River containing One Hundred acres, bound
 -eds on the East by James Campbell's land on the south
 by Elizabeth Middleton's on the West by Jesse Trammels
 on the North by lands formerly belonging to Tho. Collier
 -ahane now owned by Joseph McHenry being the same
