Jones and to his successors in Office forever All that Tract, Lot or parcel of Land known and described by a survey and plan thereof as follows Viz Beginning at a Red Oak 37 37 Thence S. 65° 53' E. 11.55 Chestnut 37 dead and down Thence down Coopers Creek to the old bed of River and along Thence to mouth of Hicks Thence up said River to a Black Gum 87 Thence W 64° 9' 30 Hickory 37 Thence S 84° W 51.00 to the beginning adjoining lands of Calvin Goodwin John H.
