

give Caroline in Trust for my daughter Eliza M Smith upon the same terms trusts and limitations as are provided for in this deed in relation to Mary A Smith and on the failure of issue of body of Eliza M Smith as above set forth in relation to Mary A Smith that then the half so held in trust for the said Eliza M Smith shall also vest absolutely in the said Martha Ann Waddill and her heirs forever

Fifth I do Trust that the issue of the said negro girl Caroline shall in all cases follow and be subject to the trusts uses and limitations expressed in this deed in relation to the said Caroline

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to provide out of my own estate for the support of the said negro girl Caroline until she leaves my possession under the provisions of this deed
