

After Cardia and others Together with all and singular things, members, indentments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining Also the following named negro slaves, Daniel, Vera, Tom, Rundung, Charles, Harriet & all the Household & Kitchen furniture which we now live, together with all the Stocks of Horses, cattle, & Hogs and I am to make the same equal in value to that that was on the place at our marriage and the other cattle & Hogs equal in numbers to that that I received at my marriage from my wife Rebecca Parton To have and to hold all and singular the said

Premises before mentioned together with the said personal property above enumerated unto the said Benjamin Hoagood his heirs executors and Administrators in Trust nevertheless for the sole and use, benefit and behoof of my said wife Rebecca Parton and her heirs and assigns, exclusive of myself & all persons claiming through or under me and the said lands & negroes & other property enumerated are to be in no wise subject to my debts contracted both to be held & kept exclusively by the said Trustees for the sole use and benefit of my wife Rebecca Parton & her heirs and assigns the said I do with full power defend all and singular the said lands and negroes & their future increase, together with the said stock of Horses, cattle, Hogs and so forth unto the said Benjamin Hoagood his heirs and assigns in Trust as aforesaid against myself and my heirs and all persons claiming or attempting to claim the same or any part thereof under me or through my assigns & vent against no one else whatsoever or in any way

It is further agreed and covenanted on my part that I do release & I do hereby release unto the said Benjamin Hoagood in Trust as aforesaid all claims which I may have to the notes, moneys & accounts of my said wife Rebecca Parton which have not been received by me or redress to my possession now and after the death of my said wife to claim better than the negroes enumerated & warranted to me in Benjamin Hoagood's covenant any portion of the said property under the marriage settlement made between us and before referred to And my said wife Rebecca Parton is at liberty to will or dispose of all the said property thus conveyed to her as well as all she may hereafter acquire to whom she pleases at her death and in case she should die without making her will or disposing of her property, then the same to be divided by the trustees for the sole use and benefit of her next of kin and be divided out amongst them according to law to the entire exclusion of me and my heirs

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 10th day of February in the year of our Lord 1854 and in the seventy eighth year of the Independence of the United States of America
