have this day granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant sell and release unto the said Albany Dallinger a certain parcel of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less beginning on a light tower stake a corner of Jordan Holcombes land & running thence N 44° 10' W a stake thence S 26° E 51 to a red oak thence N 15° 50' W a fence thence N 30° E 29, 50 to a chestnut thence to the beginning

Together with all and singular the Rights members & appurtenances therunto belonging & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said Albany Dallinger his heirs & assigns forever from the claim of all persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof
