








acres, one road and two fences more or less, being at the head of main street and on which a dwelling house stands, and other improvements are located, beginning at a stake near the dwelling house up on the East side of main street and running thence with said line, S 18 E 2 chains and 7 1/2 links to Judge Alley, thence with Judge Alley, S 73 E 2 chains and 86 links to C J Elford's lot, thence with said lot S 16 E 2 chains and 88 links to a stake, thence S 58 E 70 links to Brown street thence with Brown street S 8 E 34 links to a stake, thence due north Brown street N 89 E 5 chains and 52 links to a street of fifty feet width thence with said street N 62 W four chains and 26 links to the road which extends N E from main street being the Old Spartanburg Road, thence with said road S 85 W 5 chains and 75 links to a stake, and thence round a curved line with the fence 74 links to the beginning corner, the said four lots of land being a portion of the tract of land conveyed to me by J. B. Mallory by deed bearing date May the 12th 1852, together with all and singular the rights, manners, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and I do hereby fully and perfectly dedicate and release to the public use forever all the streets which have been opened by me upon the said tract of land, purchased from Mallory. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said C J Elford his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said C J Elford his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
