S, thence N 42 E 1480 to the beginning, containing Twelve acres more or less, Boundaries of Lands belonging to I Edwin Ware and Samuel J Waddell, together with all and singular the rights members, Rents, tithes and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in or in anywise incident.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Exors and Adms to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned and unto the said Samuel J Waddell his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against any and all persons claiming the same in any part thereof.
