comprising all the Land lying between Buncombe, Richardson, Coffee
and Laurens Streets, and being of the following dimensions, to wit
two hundred and fifty four feet on Buncombe, two hundred and four-
teen feet on Richardson Street, two hundred and four feet on
Coffee Street, and sixty six feet on Laurens Street, being the Lot of
Land conveyed to me by my Grand Father Joseph Headden Sr
by deed bearing date Fifth day of January 1847
