Know all men by these presents that I James Jackson of the state and district

above said for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the signing of these presents by Mary Jackson have bargained and sold to the sd Mary Jackson a certain tract or parcel of Land in the state and district above sd on branch water of Mush Crak branch waters of Egge river containing by estimation forty acres more or less Beginning on a white oak corner on the North side of Spring branch running N^o to a post oak on the Calmar line & thence the Calmar line to a poplar corner on the still house branch and thence with the meander of the branch to a maple corner on sd branch thence a straight line to a Persimmon on Spring branch thence down said branch a straight line to the beginning corner the sd Mary Jackson her heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said land with improvements and everything thereunto belonging from me the sd James Jackson my heirs and assigns for ever from all and every other person or persons for having or laying any just right or title or claim thereunto.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the sixth day of July eighteen hundred and fifty five his signed, sealed, and delivered in the presence of 3 James Jackson
