and conveyed by him to Wilson Barton for further description of said
land see Sheriff's deed

his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
and assigns to warrant and firm defend unto the said John
Hightower his heirs and assigns the above named premises against
myself my heirs and assigns and against no one else
