 the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas P. Ashmon
 a certain piece parcel or tract of Land containing Ten Acres situate in the State and
 District aforesaid on both sides of the head of a creek branch waters of Steady River
 Beginning at a Rock 34 0 m thence N 44 1/2 W 15 90 1/4 to Rock 34 37 0 m thence N 25 W 116 ch to Pine
 34 2 m thence N 54 6 25 ch to Rock 34 0 m thence S 38 6 17 00 ch to Rock 34 2 m thence S 54 1/2
 6 3 00 ch to Rock 34 2 m thence S 53 1/2 W 2 21 ch to the beginning Rock, Together with
 all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto
 in anywise or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas P. Ashmon his heirs
 and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs, executors and admin-
 istrators to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said Thomas
 P. Ashmon his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs, executors and
 administrators and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claim-
