 To For Greenville District
 William Harrison Land Know all men by these presents that I Reubin

Harrison of the State and District aforesaid for the inconsideration of two hundred Dollars to me paid in hand by William Harrison of the State and District above mentioned and conveyed unto the said William Harrison a tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and thirteen acres be the same more or less on the waters of Packs Creek a stream of South Tyger Bounded as follows Beginning on a chestnut oak $\text{S } 86^{\circ} 10' 57.50''$ to a Ash thence $\text{N } 12^{\circ} 1/2' \text{ W } 12^{\circ} 14'$ to Post oak thence $\text{N } 52^{\circ} 1/2' \text{ E } 27.50'$ to a ash thence up the myanders of said Branch to a stake thence $\text{S } 20^{\circ} 1/4' \text{ E } 14.60'$ to a stake thence $\text{S } 29^{\circ} 1/2' \text{ E } 19'$ to a chestnut oak the beginning corner on the top of Packs mountain Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said William Harrison his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and admors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Harrison his heirs assigns against my self and my heirs and against all and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I the said Reubin Harrison have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 7th of January one thousand eight hundred and fifty four.
