John C Hicks to A W Black	Deed for Lot	<p>The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that J C Hicks of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Four thousand Dollars to me paid by Alexander W Black in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander W Black All that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being within the Town of Greenville and State aforesaid Beginning at a stake on the Anderson Road running South 73 1/2 East 330 feet to a stake thence North 26 1/4 East 134 feet to a stake thence North 73 1/2 West 321 feet to a stake on the Anderson Road thence South 30 1/2 West 136 feet with Anderson Road to the beginning corner containing three rods and thirty five rods as per the survey of John Watson surveyed 31st August 1861 being the lot of Land purchased</p>
