of said note and Interest I have bargained sold Mortgage
and conveyed and by these Presents do bargain sell
Mortgage and convey to the said Dr John Crittenden his heirs and
assigns the entire ~~crop~~ crop of corn wheat and rye that I
may make the next year (1862) after paying the rent for
the farm and two horses one a gray and one a sorrell
and three head of Cattle with the understanding that until
default shall be made in the payment of the sum of money
aforesaid all the property hereby mortgaged is to be and remain
in my possession and that upon the payment of the said sum of
money this obligation to be utterly void and of no effect but
on the contrary should default be made in paying the said
sum of money then and in that case this obligation to be and
