This Indenture made the fifteenth
day of December in the year of

our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two, and in the eighty seventh year of the sovereignty and independence of the State of South Carolina, Between George I Hughs of the first part Emily E Green widow of Greenville District in the said State of the second part & John S Ashmon of the third part
Whenas a marriage is intended by Gods permission shortly to be had and solemnized between the said George I Hughs and the said Emilia E Green, and whenas the said Emilia E Green is possessed in her own right of seven Negroes, To wit. Adam Lucy, Elija Lavanah Frances & Andrew, also one mule two milch cows one saw and pigs four beds & bedding also a life Estate in a Tract of land containing One hundred & fifty acres, and whenas in prospect and consideration of the said intended marriage hath been agreed by and between the said parties to these presents. That all and singular the said negroes, slaves and the future issue and increase of the families together with the said household furniture cattle hogs &c, and the said life Estate in the said tract of land of which the said Emilia E Green is possessed in her own right shall be settled conveyed and disposed of to such uses and upon such trusts and to & for such intents and purposes as are hereinafter mentioned expressed and declared of and concerning the same. Now this Indenture witnesseth that in pursuance of the said agreement in consideration of the said intended marriage & for and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars apiece to them the said George I Hughs and Emilia E Green in hand well and truly paid by the said John S Ashmon, at as before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the the said Emilia E Green by and with the private consent and approbation of the said George I Hughs her intended husband testified by his being a party to and signing and sealing of these presents, doth grant bargain sell assign transfer and let over unto
