 ents that I Henry Mc Earle have this day for and in  
 consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to me  
 paid have granted bargained and sold unto Capt W C  
 Earle all that Tract of parcel of Land situate on the north  
 side of Piney Mountain in Greenville District within four  
 miles of the Village on the head of Langston's Branch, waters  
 of Keedy River, being a part of the old Sherwood Roberts  
 Tract which I bought of Wm Roberts adjoining to L H Green  
 V M Bee & Lyre Roberts Land, Beginning on a Rock on the north  
 side of the Mountain in a flat in the line of the old Roberts  
 Tract, joining the Land of Barnet Statham of Missi, and  
 running North 114 poles crossing the branch, by a W. O. Station  
 at 46 Poles 111, to an old chestnut & four small chestnuts x 111 in the  
 north line of said old Tract. Thence S 69 E 35 p<sup>d</sup>. to a small  
 Chestnut Oak west of the road from L H Green to the top of said  
 Mountain. Thence S 57 E 74 poles to a small Black Gum & Chestnut  
 W Thence S 24 W 44 poles to a Hickory near a path x 111  
 then S 60 W 89 poles along side of the Mountain to the beginning
