This Indenture made the Twentieth  
 day of March in the year of our  
 Lord One thousand eight hundred  
 and sixty three between Tho<sup>s</sup> the State  
 of the first part and William Thompson of the same place  
 on the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of  
 the first part in consideration of the sum of six thousand  
 & ninety <sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt which  
 is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold and  
 by these presents doth grant bargain sell & convey unto  
 the said party of the second part and to his heirs & assigns  
 a negro boy named Sam about ten years old, to have  
 and to hold the said negro boy Sam unto the said party  
 of the second part his heirs & assigns to his & their own  
 proper use benefit & behoof forever. Provided always and  
 these presents on upon these conditions that if the said  
 party of the first part shall well and truly pay his certain  
 promissory Note bearing even date herunto given to the said  
 party of the second part for the sum of six thousand & ninety  
<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars lawful money as aforesaid according to the tenor  
 of said note then these presents shall become void and the  
 property hereby granted shall cease and utterly determine

 set his hand and seal the day and year above written
