 A P Cornett Land Know all men by these presents that I William Cornett

of the State & District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Arletha P Cornett of State & District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Arletha P Cornett all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred & twenty four acres more or less situated in Greenville District, Lying on the North Fork of Saluda River beginning on a post oak corner and running thence South S 64 to a Red oak 34 thence E 35 chains a crop a branch to a Red oak 34 on both sides of the branch, thence a Stake 34 & thence South 30 E 35 chains 50 links to the beginning. Joining Lands of John Mattows on one side and on all other sides by Vacant Lands Together with all and singular the rights Hereditaments and Appurtenances belonging thereto the said premises and in any wise incident, I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Arletha P Cornett and her bodily heirs, her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs, self my heirs and executor & administrators unto the above Arletha P Cornett against my self my heirs Executors and. N. B. and Nancy Ann Trammell my dear beloved sister is to hold possession her life time or during pleasure.
