Deed The State of South Carolina
For Land I know all men by these presents
that I Jefferson Barton of Green
ville District in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars to me paid
by Jno W Goodwin of Greenville District in the state aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jno W
Goodwin all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying and
being in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of Bayla
Branch of Middle Saluda River, beginning at a branch down
near a Spring & runs N $45\frac{3}{4}$ E 2.96 to a chestnut sprout & thence
N $47\frac{1}{2}W10.00$ to a Pine & thence S $83\frac{1}{2}W03.25$ to a Post oak & thence
N $40\frac{1}{4}W10.31$ to a Post oak & thence N $25\frac{1}{2}W1.15$ to a Pine & thence
N $70\frac{1}{4}W22.50$ to a Spanish Oak & dead down, thence N $14W19.50$ to a
chestnut & dead and down thence N $60\frac{1}{2}W26.50$ to a chestnut & thence
running with Land belonging to the said Jno W Goodwin until it
intersects with the original tract or homestead formerly belonging
to the Estate of Samuel McJunkin at a Post oak & gone, thence along
the line of said tract S $30E19.00$ to a stone & laurelwood gone,
thence N $45E$ with the Micayah May fields Grant 21.70 to a
stone & thence S $36E$ a conditional line agreed on by David
Bly the Esr of the Estate of Samuel McJunkin and Jefferson
Barton on the 14th day of April 1858 acknowledging the same
to be the dividing line between the said parties as shown to
him David Bly the by Samuel McJunkin in his lifetime
& running 11.00 chains to a Black gum Station marked old
and new and containing some coopers, making the whole line
17.60 to a chestnut Oak & or to the back line of the Mayfield
Survey thence with said Survey N $56E52.00$ to a Stake & thence
on to a small branch thence down the branch to the beginning
containing three hundred acres more or less together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in
anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
John W Goodwin his heirs and assigns. Forever and I do
hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Jno W Goodwin his heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs and against every person or
persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof. — Witness my hand and Seal this 23rd day
of Jun in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hun-
dred and Sixty three
