Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Albert Lengnick Trustee of Eliz- abeth Lengnick his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to have out and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Albert Lengnick Trustee of Elizabeth Lengnick his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this Twenty Second day of
