Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Cram of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge ~~to~~ ^{to} hereby grant sell and convey unto Thomas C Kuss of the State aforesaid and District of Greenville a certain tract or parcel of land situate and lying in said District of Greenville on the North fork of Elisha Thompsons Beaver dam Creek containing fifty acres more or less Bounded as follows *Viz*, beginning at a stone corner on the Rutherford Road on Martha C Weaves line thence down that line to the creek thence a straight line up the creek to a stone corner thence a west course to the Rutherford road on the line of the Bens - on tract of land thence down the Rutherford road to the beginning. Together with all the privileges improvements and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Thomas C Kuss his heirs and assigns forever Clear of all incumbrances and I the said Samuel Cram do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the above mentioned premises against the lawful claim of all persons forever
