 and hundred dollars. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
 R. L. Bowden for and in consideration of the said debt or sum pay-
 able as aforesaid to the said James P. Moore Esq. Commissioner
 as aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the
 said James P. Moore Esq. Commissioner as aforesaid according
 to the Bond aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of
 three dollars by him to the said James P. Moore Esq. Commissioner
 as aforesaid to the said R. L. Bowden in hand paid at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant bargain
 sell alien release convey and confirm unto the said James P.
 Moore Esq. Commissioner in Equity and to his Successors in office forever
 all that tract or parcel of lands situated lying and being
 in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville on
 Pacolet River containing seven hundred & thirty six acres more

 the sum of twenty seven hundred dollars according to the condition
 of the Bond above mentioned then and from thenceforth these
 presents shall be utterly null and void anything herein con-
 tained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding and it
 is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these
 presents that until default shall be made in payment of the
 aforesaid sum or part thereof the said R. L. Bowden shall have
 it shall and may be lawful to and for the said R. L. Bowden
 peaceably and quietly to have use occupy possess and enjoy
 all and singular the premises above granted and released
 and every part thereof with the Appurtenances and to have
 receive lease take the rents Issues and profits thereof
 to his own particular use and behoof anything herein con-
