 berry in the State aforesaid has been
 adjudged a Bankrupt upon his own petition
 by the District Court of the United States for the District of South
 Carolina and whereas J. N. Martin has been appointed
 assignee of the Estate both real and personal of the said Bankrupt
 and whereas Henry Summer one of the Registers in Bankruptcy
 of said County did on the tenth day of July A. D. 1868 by virtue
 of the authority vested in him by the 14th section of the act of con-
 gress entitled an act to establish a uniform system of Bankru-
