Provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning
 of the parties to these presents that if the said Alfred Taylor his heirs
 executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid unto the said J. D. South Probate Judge his successors in office
 or assigns the sum of thirteen thousand and four dollars according to
 the condition of the Bond above mentioned then and from then forth
 these presents shall be utterly null and void, anything herein con-
 tained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding and
 it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties
 to these presents that until default shall be made in payment
 of the aforesaid sum as before set forth and the interest for the same
 it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Alfred Taylor peace-
 ably and quietly to hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and sing-
 ular the premises above granted and released and every part thereof

W. A. McDaniel Deed The State of South Carolina

 Alexander Bowers Land

This Indenture made the fourth day of
 January in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and sixty nine between William A. McDaniel Esquire
 Clerk of the Honorable Circuit Court for Greenville County at
 Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and
 Alexander Bowers of the other part Whereas Samuel P. Douthett
 Judge of the Probate Court for Greenville County and successor
 in office of Robert McKay former O. C. D. on or about the ninth
 day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and sixty eight exhibited his bill of Complaint in the Circuit Court
 at Chambers at Greenville Court House in the said State against
 Doctor H. Watson and Alfred J. Watson, and the cause being at-
 tained before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight when
 the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the
 premises did order adjudge and decree that the mortgage premises
 described in the Bill should be sold at Public Auction by the Clerk of the
 said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order
 as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear and
 the said William A. McDaniel as Clerk of the said Court after having
 duly advertised the said Tract of Land for sale by Public Auction on the
 first Monday of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty nine did then openly and publicly and according
 to the custom of Auction sell and dispose of the said Tract of Land
 below described unto the said Alexander Bowers for One thousand
 and six dollars he being at that price the highest bidder for the same
 Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said William A. McDaniel
 as Clerk of the said Court under and by virtue of the said decree and in
 consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said Alexander
 Bowers the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bar-
 gain sold and released and by this present hath granted bargain sell
 and released unto the said Alexander Bowers his heirs and assigns all
 that tract or lot of land situated lying and being in the County of Green-
 ville and State of South Carolina on Beaver dam Creek water of
 Anson River bounded by lands of H. P. Pool L. S. Stokes and others and
 containing thirty eight acres more or less being the same tract of
 land purchased by Elliot Watson from H. P. Pool and purchased by the
 above named D. H. and A. J. Watson from R. McKay O. C. D. at the sale of
 Elliot Watson real estate and this day sold as Lot No. 1 under a bill
 to foreclose the mortgage of D. H. Watson & A. J. Watson to R. McKay O. C. D.
 & transferred to J. D. South his successor in office together with all
 and singular the hereditaments rights Members and appurtenances whatso-
 ever to the said Tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining
 and the revenues and remainments issues and profits thereof and also
