Veckins Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such and such and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Samuel Bonds the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Bonds his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said John Bates had granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Bonds his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right and interest which the said John Bates of right had of in and to the same To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Samuel Bonds his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said A. Stone doth hereby certify that the said James A. Stone for and in consideration of the said debt or sum payable as aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Philamond Huff according to the said debt note above mentioned and also in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars by the said Philamond Huff to him the said James A. Stone in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant bargain sell alien release convey and law firm unto the said Philamond Huff and to his heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece parcel and tract of land in Granville County State of aforesaid on Quabbin Creek waters of Carrow River containing twenty five acres whereon the Mills and Landing Machinery is located and known as James A. Stone's Mills & Landing purchased by and at Sheriff sale and adjoining lands of George H. Huggins originally purchased of S. O. Huggins by James A. Stone for the purpose of Deeds of Huggins to Stone together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the same and profits thereof To have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Philamond Huff his heirs and assigns forever Provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said James A. Stone in the said County or Administration should sell or in anywise convey or be conveyed unto the said Philamond Huff the sum of four thousand
