 Mary Keill the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have given
 granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do give
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto my said daughter Mary
 Keill all that tract and parcel of land situate lying and being
 in the County and State aforsaid on both sides of Rock Creek
 waters of Reddy River containing One Hundred and eighty one and
 one fourth Acres (more or less) adjoining lands of William Choise
 Miles Hendry and lands of William Bates and Company and being
 the same tract of land which was conveyed to me by Thomas M. Coof
 and H. P. Keammatt by their deed bearing date the 13 day of October
 A.D. 1867. Beginning at a Rock & a m. on the Buncombe Road and running
