Barkins lying and being in State and Co aforesaid on Giddens Creek waters of Enoree River containing sixteen acres more or less bounded by lands of the said Josiah Bramlett Singleton Stokes and Land belonging to estate of J. C. Langin Decr beginning on a stone 54 pines 12 1/2 W 25 ch to a stone 54 pines 16 5 to 14 ch to P. O. dead 54 pines N. 5. W 26, 50 ch to the beginning including all singular the rights members hereditaments appurtenances belonging or in anywise incident to the above described Land I bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the same unto Singleton Stokes his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns and against any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof given under my hand and seal this November the 23rd A.D. 1868

Bonds of the second part - witness to that the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty Dollars to him paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents does grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all that portion of a certain tract of land known as the ~~Cruely~~ ~~Christophers~~ place which lies on the south side of the road running through said place leading from old Middle River Church to Union Church which said tract of land was conveyed to the said party of the first part by the said John Bates Sr. by deed bearing date the day of ~~Feb~~ and recorded in the office of the Register of Meigs County Georgia Book A. S. pages 139 & 140 and for a full description of which special reference is made to said deed to have and to hold all and singular the above described premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever his land for the sole and separate use benefit and behoof of the said Sarah Caroline Bonds wife of the said Valentine A.
