Thomas all that tract piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State of Georgia on both sides of Ballenger Creek Waters of Oronoe River adjoining lands of Miles Kendrick's lot Mayfield Manning's Oillard and others containing One hundred and one half Acres more or less being a part of the same tract of land conveyed by Thomas McCoy to Wm. Bates & Co. by deed dated November 20 1853 and by the heirs of Wm.
