 Whitnes Symmes Plaintiff exhibited their Complaint for Relief & D in the Court of Ammou Pleas for the County of Greenville and State aforesaid against Thomas M. Cox Thomas G. Power William Dirmie and others Defendants wherein amongst other things it was alleged that one John Westfield now deceased on the day of A.D. 1873 sold and conveyed to the plaintiff Whitner Symmes and Thomas M.
