Thence N 7 1/4 W 6, 50 Chains to a Chestnut 37 Thence N 83 E 36, 00 Chains to a Dogwood 37 Thence S 7 E 65, 00 chains to the Beginning Pine 34 containing fifty two Acres More or less bounded by lands of myself J P Hawkins Cr. and others.

Together with all and singly the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
