To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said R R Anderson and J L Woodside their heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said John L Southern might and lawfully could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise.
