Harrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of seven Dollars and fifty cents, to me in hand paid by Edward Jenkins Henry Steinhorse and Robert Stewart Trustees of Pleasant View Church, of the Presbyterian Church of Greenville County in the State aforesaid (said) Granted Bargained Sold and Released and by these presents Do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the Edward Jenkins Henry Steinhorse and Robert Stewart Trustees of Pleasant View Church, Presbyterian Church and their Successors in office a certain piece parcel or lot of Land containing One Acre and three quarters be the same more or less, situate in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on a branch of South Rabun's Creek bounded by lands of J. B. Thurston Josiah Wasson and said J. R. Harrison Beginning at a Stone 3 x 3 x 7 m. Thence N 72° E 65 ch to Road Thence with said Road 62-0 ch to Stone 3 x 3 x 7 m Thence S 63 1/2° W 57-0 ch to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Edward Jenkins Henry Steinhorse and Robert Stewart Trustees of Pleasant View Church of Presbyterian Church and their Successors in office forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edward Jenkins Henry Steinhorse and Robert Stewart Trustees as aforesaid of Pleasant View Church of the Presbyterian Church and their Successors in office against myself and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this the sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Seventy six and in the one hundredth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America
