Know, all men by these presents,
that I Mary Taylor of Greenville

county in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum
of Four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before
the sealing of these presents, by Thomas W Davis in the State
aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have
granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do
give, ratify bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas W Davis
all that tract of land lying and being in the County of Greenville
and State aforesaid, some ten miles East of the City of Greenville
and three miles from Greens Station, on the Air Line Rail Road
on Branch Waters of Eucree River, containing twenty two
acres, be the same more or less having the following boundaries
to wit: beginning at a stone \times on a branch thence N 39
W 73 1/2 to a Post oak \times 3 Thence N 81 1/4 W 250 to a stone
 \times 3 thence N 56 E 100 to a stone \times 3 thence N 62 1/2 E 135 to
a stone \times 3 thence S 42 E 55 to a stone \times 3 thence N 63 1/2
E 110 to a stone \times 3 thence S 55 E 187 to stone on the Branch
thence with the said branch to the beginning corner on
said Branch see plat hereto annexed for a more descrip-
tion by J. W. Wood surveyor together with all and
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or apper-
taining, do have and to hold all and singular the said
premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas W Davis his
heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my heirs
executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas
W Davis his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this fifth
day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hun-
dred and seventy six and in the one hundred and thirtieth year of
the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of
America.
