Know all men by these presents, that I A D Horne of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of

the sum of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Robert A D Hardin in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert A D Hardin all that tract of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid joining lands of Taylor Williams and others, on the East side of Enoree River containing One hundred acres more or less having the following boundary to wit: Beginning on an old White oak or near a Branch of Tick Creek, thence up said Creek to the fork thence up the South fork to a White oak corner, joining Hardin or Roberts ~~old~~ line; Thence with Hardin Roberts line to a Post oak; Thence to the beginning corner, with the exception of a life estate sold by William A Canble to Edward E. Bridwell in a Deed to a portion of three acres this being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Deed of W A Canble dated the first day of August A D 1867

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Robert A D Hardin his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert A D Hardin his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
