Know all men by these presents that I Harriet J. Garrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred (400) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by David V. Garrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said David V. Garrison, his heirs and assigns all the right title and interest of any and every character and description, conveyed to me by the last will and testament of my husband Charles J. Garrison, deceased, in or certain parcel or tract of land being lying and situate in the State and County aforesaid in Oak Lawn Township, on both sides of the Wilson Bridge Road and near Saluda River; containing One hundred and ten (110) Acres more or less and having the following marks and boundaries, viz:

Beginning at a P. O. 37 1/2 m and running thence S 72 1/2 W 35.05 to a stone 37 1/2 m thence N 21 W 9.22 to a stone 37 1/2 m thence S 71 W 11.00 to a stone 37 1/2 m thence S 21 1/2 E 21.50 to a stone 37 1/2 m on the north side of the Wilson Bridge Road, thence along and diagonally across said Road N 64 E 5.50 to a stone 37 1/2 m on the south side of the Newcut Road and near the intersection of said Roads, thence S 77 1/4 E 5.85 to an angle in the newcut Road thence N 83 E 5.80 to stone 37 1/2 m in angle of same Road thence S 26 1/2 E 9.47 to a stone 37 1/2 m on west side of same Road, thence S 46 1/4 E 6.00 to a stone 37 1/2 m in center and at an angle of same Road, thence S 83 1/4 E 6.75 to a stone 37 1/2 m on north side of same Road, thence N 39 1/4 E 23.25 to a P. O. 37 1/2 m thence N 83 1/2 W 19.80 to beginning corner.
