Whereas John W. Stokes as Plaintiff instituted an action against J. Henry Stokes and Theodore A. Stokes on the 28th day of August A.D. 1876 in the Probate Court for said County for the purpose among other things, to partition the Real Estate of John J. Stokes decd among said plaintiff and Defendants, and whereas a writ of Partition to divide said Real Estate among said parties was issued by me, the Probate Judge of said County directed to Willis D. Threlkeld, Williams K. Wasson and Jonathan Miller, and whereas said commissioners did divide said Real Estate among said John W. Stokes, J. Henry Stokes and Theodore A. Stokes and did allot and assign unto J. Henry Stokes, the Mill tract of land containing five hundred and twenty eight acres, and particularly described in a plat accompanying their returns, and whereas I have ordered and decreed, that deeds be made to said parties to the tracts assigned to them respectively. Now therefore know all men by these presents that I Samuel J. Douthitt Judge of the Court of Probate for said County for and in consideration of said premises and also in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me paid by J. Henry
