Know all men by these presents  
that H. H. McAuley of

the State and County aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum  
of One hundred and twenty five Dollars to me in hand paid by Edward  
Batson of the State and County aforesaid the receipt I do acknow-  
ledge have granted bargained sold and released and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Edward  
Batson all that piece of Land situate in the State and County afo-  
resaid lying on the Jones Gap Road containing Twenty Six and  
a half Acres be the same more or less beginning on a Persim-  
mon on said Road thence running down said Road S 28 E  
14 chains and 60 links to a stake thence S 6 7/8 W 10 chains and  
15 links to a Black Jack thence N 45 1/2 W 7 chains and 39 links to  
a pine thence S 7 1/2 W 1 chain and 1 link to a pine on stake on  
branch thence S 75 1/2 W 8 chains 25 links to a stake on branch  
thence N 29 W 10 chains and to a stake thence N 82 E 18 chains  
and 90 links to the beginning persimmon. Together with all  
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenan-  
ces to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or  
appertaining, To have and to hold and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Edward Batson his heirs and  
assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and  
administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said Edward Batson his heirs and assigns  
against myself my heirs and against every person or persons  
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
