Buist and William A. Williams their heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves, our executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said interest unto the said Eliza F. Buist and William A. Williams, their heirs and assigns, from and against ourselves and our heirs, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
