Bee all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville containing three and 6/10 acres more or less beginning on a stake 3x on Reedy River and running thence S. 19 1/4 W. 25 links to a stake 3x thence S. 29 W. 9.83 along Westfield Street to a stake 3x thence N. 5 1/2 E. 6.68 to a stake 3x thence N. 61 E. 5.50 to a White Oak 3x thence N. 59 1/2 E. 180 to a White Oak 3x thence N. 42 W. 1.10 to a Persimmon 3x on the bank of Reedy River thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.
