Bartley his heirs and assigns a certain parcel or tract of land being lying and situate in the State and County aforesaid on Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda River containing seventy nine acres more or less and having the following wrights boundaries &c. viz Beginning at a Hickory 22 m N E of Mill house and running thence by 1/4 W 3.47 to cotton wood 22 m thence N 72 W about 1.20 to a stone 22 m on West bank of Creek thence up the bank of said Creek including all of the water of said Creek to a stump 22 m thence N 2 1/2 W 12.53 to a stone 22 m
