Freeman of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, have granted bargain-sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain-sell and release, unto the said Alice E. Freeman all that piece parcel or lot of land lying being and situate in the City and County of Greenville, and State aforesaid beginning on the S W corner of Echo Kilgore's corner running thence S 55 W 158 chains to a stake thence S 34 1/2 E 3.16 chains to a stake thence N 55 E 158 chains to a stake thence N 34 1/2 W 3.16 chains to the beginning corner containing one half of one acre more or less adjoining lots of Echo Kilgore & others

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alice E. Freeman her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alice E. Freeman her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
