Know all men by these presents that J M Styles do bargain sell and release unto Simpson Bishop a certain piece of land lying and being on Enoree River running down the land bridges commencing on a Rock corner running East 94 ninety four rods to a rock on the bank of the river thence South 10 ten rods to a passafras thence 16 sixteen rods South West to a rock thence 75 seventy five rods West to a rock thence 9 1/2 nine and a half rods to the beginning corner adjoining lands of James Clark James Roe and others J M Styles for the sum of seventy Dollars paid me by Simpson Bishop for the above piece of land supposed to be seven acres more or less on the meanders of said river do warrant and defend against any person or persons claiming or having any claim against said piece of land
