Harris all that piece parcel and lot of Land contain- ing Seven one hundredths (7/100) of an Acre more or less situ- ate in the Western part of the City of Greenville on the South side of Puddledon Street, and bounded on the East by Heahns lot, and on the South and West by my lot, - Beginning at Heahns corner on Puddledon Street, and running thence with said Street in a direct line towards my store, thence S 25° E to a stake or thence S 19 1/2° E 106 1/2° F in a line parallel with my store house to a stake 3 x thence N 70 1/2° E 24 1/2° F to a stake or on Heahns line, thence N 19 W 6 1/2° F with said line to a stake or corner of Heahns store. thence N 11 1/4° W 40° F with said store to the beginning corner on Puddledon Street, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W. L. Harris his heirs and assigns forever, and do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said prem- ises unto the said W. L.
