Bowman & W. Bowman & Co Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertain- ing To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said James A. Beaumont his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said James A.
