Together with all and singular the right members heretofore and otherwise to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Heirs of William Few dead and their posterity forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Heirs of William Few dead and their posterity forever against us and our heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof
