Know all men by these presents
that I William H Murrel

of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in
consideration of One hundred and seventy five Dollars to
me paid by the Mayor and Aldermen of the said City of
Greenville have granted bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Mayor and Aldermen a piece parcel and strip of
land thirty feet wide along the entire length of the East side
of my lot of land on Buncome Street in said City of Green-
ville said strip of land being the street between my lot and
the premises of Mrs Emma Lipscombe Together with all and
singular the rights members Hereditaments and Appurtenances
to said strip of land belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said
strip of land to the said Mayor and Aldermen of said
City of Greenville their successors in office and assigns forever
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Adm-
inistrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said strip of land to the said Mayor and Aldermen of
said City of Greenville their successors in office and assigns
against me and my heirs and against every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
part thereof
